### Call for applications for the postgraduate programme

#### *MA in Linguistics, 2016-2017*

#### School of English Language and Literature, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece

The School of English Language and Literature is accepting applications for the admission of twenty (20) students to the postgraduate programme *MA in Linguistics* for the academic year 2016-2017, as decided in the Special Faculty General Meeting, No 212/31-5-2016. The duration of the programme is 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time.

Application forms and all other required documents should be submitted in hard copy to the Registrar's office (Administration Building "K. Karatheodori", 3rd floor, University Campus, 54124 Thessaloniki, Greece), Mon-Fri, 10.00-12.00. Applicants can also post their application by the application deadline. They should keep a legible proof of posting and they should ensure the prompt delivery of their application which should reach Registrar's office not later than 2/9/2016.

**Application period: 14 July 2016 to 29 August 2016.**

**Required documents:**

- Completed application form, printed and electronic.
- Curriculum Vitae.
- Copy of undergraduate degree. Graduates of foreign universities are also required to provide a copy of their degree certified by the Hellenic National Academic Recognition and Information Center (DOATAP), when necessary as indicated under law 4316/2014, article 73, par. 5.
- Transcript listing all courses and grades and final average grade.
- Copies of other degrees (if there are any).
- Personal statement with brief information about the applicant's academic background, knowledge, skills, abilities and the reasons for applying for the specific MA.
- Certificate of language proficiency in English (at least level C1) for non-native speakers of English who are not graduates of Schools of English Language and Literature.
- Research papers, publications ( in electronic form) and distinctions (if there are any)
- Two academic letters of recommendation and a letter of recommendation from an employer (if there is one)
- Certificate of professional experience (if there is one)
- Bank receipt for a 15 Euros deposit for the application fee (Aristotle University ELKE Bank Account, Piraeus Bank, IBAN GR 250172202000 5202072402367). The receipt should include the following details: name of candidate, code number 93770, and the phrase “for the Postgraduate Programme of the School of English Language and Literature: MA in Linguistics.”
