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AREAS OF RESEARCH:

During my PhD studies I have attempted to build bridges among various 'islands' of the **Cognitive Linguistics** 'archipelago' such as Cognitive Grammar, Construction Grammar, CMT and Frame Semantics. I have investigated the evocation of the literal and the figurative meanings of the grammatical category of English phrasal verbs.

The area of **Critical Discourse Analysis (advertising, media** and **political discourse**) draws my attention. I am currently working on an interdisciplinary approach to Internet marketing and I investigate the case of social media. My current research attempts to build bridges among the disciplines of marketing, advertising and (Cognitive) Linguistics. The research suggests that multimodality serves as a marketing communication strategy.

Moreover, **applied linguistics** and **ESP/EAP** constitute a central area of investigation. I apply a cognitive linguistics approach to the instruction of English as a Second/Foreign Language and I follow a task-based grammar methodology.
