Research Interests

My research focuses on the construction and presentation of characters in literary texts. Specifically, I am interested in the interactions between characters in Ovid's *Metamorphoses* and the nexus created among them by multiple narrative levels. Central to this work is also the question of how the reader engages with the characters and understands their thoughts, emotions, and intentions, attributing to them specific mental states. Given the exceptional epic character of the *Metamorphoses*, my investigation prioritizes the stylistic devices that reveal how the poet/narrator actively constructs and manipulates the reader's embodied experience of the narrative. I address these by applying an interdisciplinary approach drawing on Cognitive Narratology, Cognitive Linguistics, and the Philosophy of Mind.
